GOT SOME TIME TO FILL BEFORE THE TAG-ALONG TOURS STARTS... CONSIDER DOING THE AUSTRALIAN DINOSAUR GIANTS GUIDED TOUR

Before the Tag-along tour starts, you will have time to do the first tour of the Australian Dinosaur Giants Tour at 9.00am to 10.00am and then have time for morning tea.

ITINERARY

- 10.45am - Road Safety Induction and introductions
- 11.00am - Tour departs
- 1.00pm - Arrive at dig site, site induction, meet dig team and have lunch
- 2.00pm - 3.00pm Dig site viewing
- 3.15pm - Depart dig site
- 4.45pm - Arrive back at ENHM

ROAD CONDITIONS AND SAFETY

There is 63kms of sealed and 55kms of gravel road to the dig site. The last 5kms is a rough, slow bush track. Please drive to the conditions of the road, with your driving lights on and allow at least two or three seconds or two car lengths distance between each vehicle on the sealed road sections. The gravel roads will most likely be dusty so if you are driving in dust, it is important to have your driving lights on and only drive at about 50-60kms/hr or what feels safe.

If you encounter Road Trains on the sealed sections of road, please give yourself plenty of time to slow down and put all your wheels off the sealed road and give the Road Train the full width of the sealed road. Sometimes it may even be necessary to stop completely. This should avoid the Road Train putting any wheels off the sealed road and spraying gravel at your vehicle.

Keep a good look out for kangaroos, emus, wedge tail eagles and other birds, sheep and cattle that may be on the road or crossing the road. If you hit any of these you will not only harm the animal you will most likely cause damage to your vehicle.

The leading 4wd will always be the ENHM Tour Guides vehicle. There isn't a good mobile signal from about 10kms outside of Eromanga. Handheld radios will be given to each vehicle, please ensure your radio is turned on and on channel 40. Your tour guide will talk to you during your journey and may ask you to stop at points of interest on your way out to the dig site. If you need to stop at other times please use the hand held radio to inform the Tour Guide.
